ANNUAL DISTRIBUTION EVENT HELD IN FIVE DISTRICTS

CHINAR held annual distribution event for children enrolled under the Child Development Program across Srinagar, Shopian, Baramulla, Budgam and Kupwara. As the new academic session began, CHINAR organized the event to ensure that children have the necessary school supplies to succeed as they promote to new grades. Over 500 children received these kits. Besides, first aid kits were given to 120 families.





LEARNING CIRCLE MEET - TEACH WITH CHINAR FELLOWS

CHINAR organized its inaugural Learning Circle Meet(LCM) with the eight fellows enrolled in Teach CHINAR fellowship program at the Srinagar office. The primary objective of the meeting was to provide a platform for fellows to share and reflect upon their experiences since the program's inception. The event was marked by the enthusiastic participation of TFI fellow- Syed Shoaib, who is presently interning with CHINAR. He actively engaged in insightful discussions with the fellows and offered guidance on overcoming challenges encountered in their respective schools.



ANNUAL PARENT TEACHER MEET AT BARAMULLA

CHINAR organized Annual Parent Teacher Meeting(PTM) at two government schools in Baramulla. The purpose of PTM was to raise awareness about the importance of parental participation in child's educational journey. Besides, it also strengthens the relationship with the community members and provides an active platform for parents to know about the academic progress of their children. Both the events witnessed the participation of over 100 parents alongwith Head of Institutions(HOIs), community heads and volunteers.

TWO SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTERS LAUNCHED IN KUPWARA

 CHINAR inaugurated two Skill Development Centers in Handwara Tehsil of Kupwara district. The first center was launched in
Check Duddipora village which enrolled 20 enthusiastic women in a comprehensive six-month cutting and tailoring course.
Another center was started at Maratgam village, where 20 women enrolled for a three- month training course on crewel embroidery. Through the provision of these specialized training courses, the organization is nurturing local talent and providing avenues for self-employment.
672 youth have graduated from 41 skill development centers till date.



In July 2022, CHINAR International established a community learning center (CLC) in my village, enrolling 35 students from different classes. These students initially lacked basic knowledge, including alphabets and fundamental concepts. I prioritized their understanding over grades and implemented the "learning by doing" approach, using activities to enhance their learning experience. With guidance from CHINAR International, I learned and adopted effective teaching strategies that emphasized active learning. I also discovered the value of informative wall charts to create an engaging learning environment. As a result, the students have gained confidence and now speak confidently on various topics in English and their mother tongue. They have acquired knowledge of alphabets, words, sentences and language concepts.
