# **Digital Learning Center Launched In Kulgam**

CHINAR International launched a Digital Learning Centre (DLC) at Ahmedabad village in Kulgam. A total of 30 students, both girls and boys, with limited access to digital learning have been enrolled in the course. The DLC aims to teach digital literacy skills to students so that they can become future ready. This is the third batch of trainees under CHINAR to whom basic computer skills are being provided in Kulgam district.

# Another Small Business Unit Launched In Baramulla

Mohd. Rajab Malla (28), a specially-abled yet impassioned young man from Baramulla is the sole provider for his family of six which includes his ailing parents, sister, wife, and one child. He used to run a small barbeque shop from a room in his house to earn his livelihood but the meagre income hardly met his financial needs. His struggle intensified during the COVID lockdown and the financial constraints completely crippled his business. CHINAR reached out to him and enrolled him under the Small Business Support (SBS) Project. He was provided with a grocery store as an extension to his barbecue shop. The business idea is marketable and he expects to earn a good profit.

### Parvaaz Survey Continues In Srinagar & Baramulla

After thorough ground research, CHINAR began the survey process for the selection of marginalized communities in the month of January. The baseline survey which included 200 household assessments has been completed in 3 areas - Palpora, Rakhe aarat (Bemina) and Mehjoornagar of Srinagar district. Identification of other deserving communities continues in other districts. More than 300 families were surveyed across 3 villages - Mundyari, Shalboni and Harinara in Baramullah. Digitization of data is also in progress for the villages under survey.











### Two Stakeholder Meetings **Held In Shopian**

CHINAR conducted two stakeholder meetings in two villages - Gatipora and Herpora of Shopian district - to identify target communities in need of intervention under the Parvaaz project. Both meetings were attended by community heads, masjid heads, sarpanch, ward members and local youth. The purpose was to educate the community CHINAR programs and deserving families in consultation community members.
