TEACHER CAPACITY BUILDING

CHINAR conducted two-day capacity building training for 44 community facilitators from 7 districts in Srinagar. The training focused on advanced lesson planning, language teaching, classroom management and 21st century skills. A similar training was organized for 22 teachers from two low budget local schools, in collaboration with Education Trust, Srinagar.

TWO SBS UNITS LAUNCHED

CHINAR launched two Small Business Support(SBS) units in Shopian. Imtiyaz Shah, who is passionate about sketching and calligraphy, got assistance to set up his art studio. Another candidate, Waseem Sheikh, who is experienced in repairing motors had submitted a business plan to expand his business by adding spare parts to it. CHINAR provided him with all necessary support to launch his unit. Currently, 38 SBS units are functional across different districts, with 2 more in the pipeline.



COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

As a part of Parvaaz, CHINAR conducted community meetings across five communities in Srinagar, Baramulla and Shopian. The purpose of the meeting was to strengthen the relationship with the community and understand their pressing problems. Each meeting had 25–30 participants including community heads, sarpanch, youth, parents and guardians and school principals.

So far, 30 community meetings were held under Parvaaz.

YOUTH GRADUATE IN MULTIPLE SKILLS

CHINAR successfully closed four skill development centers in Baramulla and Bandipora. Fifty youth graduated from these centers in multiple skills - cutting and tailoring, tilla embroidery, digital learning and electrical courses. All the trainees received certificates of completion from the organization. Two toppers in tailoring course were given sewing machines to kickstart their units. Besides, two new centers for tailoring and digital literacy were started in Baramulla, in collaboration with Industrial Training Institute, J&K.



ONE DAY TRAINING FOR FIELD STAFF (PARVAAZ)

CHINAR organized one-day orientation program for field staff working under Parvaaz across four districts - Srinagar, Shopian, Baramulla and Srinagar. Attended by 10 field monitors, the purpose of the training was to brief them about programs, guidelines and protocols, selection criteria and community engagement strategies.
